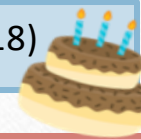

Year 13 – If you still have not collected your GCSE certificates, please also do this as soon as possible.



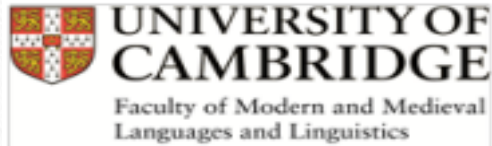
Message on behalf of Mrs Moore:
