Summer Maths Tuition for Pupils Moving to Abbey College: TUTOR

Abbey College is partnering with Complete Mathematics to provide TUTOR, an intelligent online tutoring system for your child over the summer holidays. Your child's new teacher will be able to use the information from TUTOR to support your child in their maths lessons from September even more effectively. TUTOR will help your child review and improve their maths through a mixture of videos and quizzes — it is easy to use, personalised and your child has unlimited access to all of the online lessons. We would love to get all of our new Year 7s logging and doing some maths over the summer to help support their transition to secondary school by reinforcing their learning from Key Stage 2. When we return in September, we will be awarding Spirit points for students who have logged in and completed some activities, allowing them to make progress towards their Bronze Award. We will also be able to see your child's individual strengths and weaknesses, allowing us to support and challenge them appropriately as soon as they arrive with us.

To get started, point your phone camera at the QR code on the right — this will take you to a sign-up page (tutor.completemaths.com/register) where you can create your child's account by selecting 'Pupil' at sign up. Enter the code 3usf2qy to sign up for an account linked to Abbey College: instructions here.



What is Complete Mathematics TUTOR?

Complete Mathematics TUTOR is an online maths platform designed to be an affordable, but an equally effective, alternative to private tuition. TUTOR covers every level of maths from learning to count all the way to advanced calculus. Once your child has completed the diagnostic, TUTOR chooses the right starting point for them and assigns a 'Stage' course - their personalised tuition pathway.



TUTOR breaks maths topics down into points called 'Goals' that together make up the whole Map of Maths. Every Goal follows the same learning sequence: based on evidence of how we learn and drawing on the neuroscience of memory, we can assess the underlying (or 'pre-requisite') knowledge needed for each point on the map, and then through expert instruction, practice questions and quizzing, make sure that point is learned and remembered, in around 15-20 mins.

TUTOR contains over 1600 Goals, so there will always be a new topic for pupils to explore!

How can I support my child using TUTOR?

You can support your child by encouraging them to log in from home and work through the videos and quizzes available to them, even learning alongside them.
