

History – Enrichment Programme

This term, you have focused on closing the gaps in History in your knowledge & understanding by revising specific aspects of the 5 units & answering exam questions. By **31st August** you should have submitted at least **10 exam questions in total** for the term. This includes the **2 essays** on **Ramsey Abbey** (set in April). & all the revision questions you did in June & July. Your answers should include **5 extended answers**: (9, 10, 12 or 15 mark question) & **5 essays** (an 18, 20 or 25 mark question). Use the **course booklets** (all stored in **Class Materials**) to check any details.

Before you '**push for purple**', you must complete your exam technique revision. Find exam questions in the **GCSE HISTORY REVISION QUESTIONS BOOKLET**. **Pages 1-3** have **guidance on how to answer the different questions**. which you **MUST** study before answering them.

1. Ramsey Abbey (c.969 - c.1600)

Your revision resources should help you to understand life in a monastery in the medieval period **and** how we can use physical evidence to show this **and** how the sites of these monasteries compare to Ramsey Abbey's site.
