Year 11 Targeted Learning Provision – Half Term Coursework and Mastery Sessions

Trial 2 exams are just around the corner and the summer exam season is rapidly approaching. We are offering half term Mastery Sessions or Coursework Completion Sessions for Year 11 students.

The Maths session is available to all, and other subjects are targeted at specific students identified by Lead Learners.

We would like you to actively encourage your child to attend these sessions as they are an additional opportunity to develop knowledge and understanding, as well as refine and develop skills or complete required coursework tasks.

These sessions will take place in the half term week of 19th February and will be led by subject teachers and GCSE curriculum experts.

- Monday and Tuesday - Engineering and Information Technology 9.30-3.10 (targeted students)
- Wednesday – Maths 10-1pm (open to all Year 11 students)
- Thursday -Geography 9.30-12.30pm (targeted students)
- Friday -History 10-12pm (targeted students)

Booking will be available through the OOP section of Edulink.

Although all students are invited to the Maths sessions, there are only 30 places available for Higher Maths and 25 places available for Foundation Maths (if there are more students wanting to attend than places, Dr Pinnock will set up a waiting list). Other subjects will be available to students selected by Lead Learners.

Please log in to Edulink to see which subjects are available to your child and to book them on. By booking your child in we will know numbers for the registers and the quantity of resources required.

Students attending for a full day should bring refreshments/lunch (the school canteen will be closed, and no students may leave the site).

Students are not required to wear school uniform however they are expected to follow the Sixth Form uniform policy. The following is a list of items not permitted:
