Dear Parents and Carers,

Pre-Easter Supporting Success Workshops for Parents

We would like to invite you to a workshop event on Wednesday 27th March, 4:30pm – 5:45pm, exploring how you can support your child with their revision and well-being in the run up to the summer exams. We know how critical the final few weeks of preparation are in ensuring that all of our students finish their courses in the summer with the grades that they need to secure their next steps. We also know that at this time of year students receive a lot of feedback from their trial exams and can find it overwhelming to plan and prioritise their revision. With this in mind, we are offering two workshops that will run in parallel:

- **Option 1:** For parents/carers of students studying Foundation tier maths, we have an external speaker from the Inspire Education Group running a workshop on how parents can support students to succeed in their Maths exams
- **Option 2:** For parents/carers of students studying Higher tier maths the workshop will consist of an opportunity to hear from Maths, English and Science specialists about subject specific revision, general strategies to support students revising at home and some information about the formal processes surrounding the summer exams

Following both workshops there will be tea/coffee and an opportunity to talk to lead learners from a range of subjects as well our exams and careers leads, and to collect some subject-specific information about what students should be working on over the Easter break.
