Foreword

It's that time of the year when we begin preparations for our incoming Year 7s, with their Induction taking place on Thursday 30th June and Friday 1st July respectively. Students from our feeder primaries will participate in a series of workshops and activities to help them navigate their way around the school, make friends and get to know staff. In addition, our Rewards and Behaviour systems will be explained, and where to find information about the curriculums they will study. Our Prefects and Sports Leaders will be on hand during the day to ensure they are well cared for and do not get lost around the campus.

Assessment

- Year 8 end of year reports are due out next Friday on 01.07.22. Year 10 reports will be published the following Friday.
- Year 7 and 8 are currently having reading tests. These take place online and the data is used to measure reading age, progress after interventions and help to determine what to focus upon moving forward.
- Year 7 students sat progress tests in Maths and English at the start of the year. There will be follow up testing in the week of 27.06.22. No preparation is necessary and the

individualised progress test reports will be sent out to parents as soon as they come into school.

- Year 12 end of year assessments begin in the week of 27.06.22. Students should be aware of the nature and content of the assessments before they sit them.
- AQA board apologised to all Year 11 students nationally after a GCSE physics paper included a question on a topic that had been specifically ruled out in advance information. All pupils who sat higher-tier paper 1 will be awarded the full nine marks available for all parts of a question on energy transfers and circuits.
