
As we break up on a Wednesday, there will be no Weekly Update sent on Friday, instead we will send our Community Round-up on Monday 18th.



Assessment calendar: How your child is doing?

Students Reports: These are filed under 'Documents' in Edulink.

- Year 7 progress tests in English, Maths, Science and the CAT4 are now all on Edulink. If you are having a problem accessing Edulink then please contact JOswell@abbey.college.
- The Year 11 results release will be on Monday 18th December. The reports will be available on Edulink on Tuesday 19th December. For the first time the reports will contain a Progress 8 (P8) score. This number represents how much progress a student has made since Key Stage 2. The baseline for P8 is the Key Stage 2 reading and maths tests which the government use to predict GCSE outcomes. The National average for P8 is set at 0 and a score of 0.5 indicates that a student is half a grade above where they expected to be, across all their subjects, and is making excellent progress. A score of -1 indicates significant underperformance and suggests that extra effort and organisation are needed before the February Trials. Your child should be able to discuss their plan to increase their P8 score with you and if they have a good plan then staged rewards leading to the end of February trials are a great idea.
- Year 13 trial results will be issued on the last day of term. They will include a current grade and an updated professional prediction.
