We were alerted yesterday that on Monday 29th April, Hollow Lane will be closed between 9:30am-2:30pm for resurfacing. Of course, emergency vehicle access will be granted, if required. However, we are at the mercy of the workforce and will only know on the day, where it will take place and if the resurfacing will be completed by 2:30pm as the tarmac will need sufficient time to set. There will be temporary traffic lights in place to regulate the traffic.

I will keep you posted on the outcome of our Local Highways Improvement bid which is due to be heard by The Hunts Cambridgeshire Local Highway Improvement Panel on the 2nd May.

The virtue of the week is 'Humility' and the theme is, 'We take responsibility for our actions and the environment'. During assemblies, and our morning briefings with pupils, they were asked to explore what it means to 'take responsibility and how they might show this. Often, when some young people are challenged over their actions, their initial response is to either say things that minimise their impact or to deflect the issue on to others that may have been involved. It is important that we teach students that if they get things wrong, the first response should be an acceptance and apology for their part in whatever took place, and 'honesty is the best policy'.


