The weather finally looks to be changing for the better, and as a result, there is an air of optimism and positivity on show as we wait for the sun to shine. With that in mind, below is some guidance on managing the warmer weather.

Uniform: Thank you for your ongoing support in ensuring that your children come to school smart and ready to learn. We do not have a summer uniform at Abbey College and our expectations remain the same throughout the year. When the weather gets consistently warmer, we will notify parents and students that blazers can be removed. If we have an exceptionally warm spell of weather, then we will allow students the option of coming to school in their PE kit for that duration and will notify parents that this is the case.

Hydration: As the weather gets warmer, it is important that students remain hydrated. We have water coolers in school that students are permitted to use at break and lunchtime. It is not possible for students to fill their bottles outside of these times so please ensure that your child comes to school with a bottle large enough to keep them going for at least two hours.

Sun protection: Please ensure students apply sun protection before school.

The virtue of the week is 'Intuition' and the theme is, 'We actively listen and remember the detail'. During assemblies, and our morning briefings with pupils, they were asked to explore what:

- it means to actively listen?
- techniques are available to support them to remember what has been learnt?
- technique they will focus upon improving their ability to listen?

One of the most important things that parents and carers can do to support your child's education is to ensure they are in school every day. Attendance at school nationally has not recovered from precovid levels and we continue to look for ways to ensure we are encouraging all students to attend every day. We were delighted this week to hit 94% attendance last week with - well done to all. There is a strong correlation between attendance and outcomes, and outcomes open up life chances which is why we take attendance so seriously.

There has been fantastic attendance at our 'OOP' offer this year with students engaging well with the evening online revision sessions, the in-school revision booster sessions. I would like to acknowledge the outstanding commitment from the Abbey College staff to these opportunities. They really do go the extra mile for our students, and I know that you are as grateful to them as I am.

Options update

Thank you for allowing us time to support our students that have been impacted by oversubscription and undersubscription to courses. We are working with students to ensure they feel supported in making new choices. This has delayed the confirmation of all Yr8 option allocations until the end of May.






