# **Update letter for families – 17<sup>th</sup> September**

You will probably be aware that the government has this week decided to offer the Covid-19 vaccine to all children aged 12-15 in England this autumn. The vaccination programme will be administered and run by healthcare staff from the NHS-commissioned <u>School Age Immunisation Service</u> (SAIS), who will be legally responsible for the delivery of the vaccine. You can read the government's <u>full guidance on the vaccination</u> programme here.

A summary of the guidance is below:

- Like all school-based vaccination programmes, the vaccines will be administered by the SAIS and will follow the usual approach to school-based immunisation.
- A consent form and information leaflet provided by the SAIS Team will be used to seek parental consent. Parents will also be provided with a contact number for the SAIS Team in case of any queries. Forms should be returned by the deadline agreed with the team.
- If you have any comments to make, please direct them to the SAIS Team once the information has been sent home.

Schools will play a limited role in supporting the programme. We will perform the following tasks:

- provide information to the SAIS provider on which children on the school roll are eligible for the vaccine:
- share the information leaflet, consent form and invitation letter supplied by the SAIS team with parents and children;
- provide the space within school, and the time away from the timetable, to enable vaccinations to take place.

I am aware that vaccination and issues of consent are a matter that some people hold strong views about. I wish to make it clear to all parents and carers that no school staff or members of the Governors will be drawn into discussion or correspondence around the matter.

I have instructed staff to offer no advice or comment on the matter to either students or families. The only information we will share will be official information provided by SAIS or the government, or details regarding the process such as the consent forms, reminders and invitation letters.

I encourage all of you to carefully read the guidance, the supporting '<u>Useful Links</u>' and <u>FAQ</u>s that I have <u>linked</u> within this letter. It is detailed and covers all the aspects around consent and the vaccination itself that you are likely to need.

We will be in contact in due course with further details when they become available.

### **Covid home testing**

Please encourage your child to test twice weekly testing at home, on a Monday and Thursday and report the results to both the school, via **Test Register** and to the NHS.
