Dear Parents/Carers

Update letter for families – 8th October

Based on the most recent data from the LA - Fenland, Huntingdonshire and Peterborough - have seen high and rapidly increasing rates of Covid-19. Some of our neighbouring authorities, such as North Northants, are also seeing significant case rises and the rates in other areas of Cambridgeshire remain concerning. As seen nationally, Public Health England (PHE) expect cases to continue at these levels and potentially rise in the next couple of weeks.

Therefore, as we have just two weeks left of school this half term, and it would be a real shame for students to miss out on face-to-face taught lessons, we are implementing the following preventative measures as of Monday 11th October until Friday 22nd October:

- We expect that face masks are worn in all corridors and communal areas but not in classrooms, unless students are exempt. No student will be penalised for not wearing a face covering.
- Please encourage your child to test twice weekly testing at home, on a Monday and Thursday and report the results to both the school, via [Test Register](#) and to the [NHS](#).
- Please do not send your child into school if they test positive.

If your child has to self-isolate, blended learning work will be available on MS Teams, which will be loaded up within the first 20 minutes of a lesson.

Keeping classrooms well ventilated is one of our main controls. As the weather is changing, we advise that students consider wearing their school jumpers under their blazers to help maintain a good level of thermal comfort.

Covid-19 vaccination update

We are still awaiting details of when the Covid vaccines for 12 - 15-year-olds will be rescheduled. Be assured that we will write to families as soon as we are informed by the NHS-commissioned [School Age Immunisation Service](#) (SAIS). Reminder of Covid Related Absence Recording

Below is a reminder of the [statutory attendance rules](#) schools have to follow.

- Students who have symptoms of COVID-19, or have had a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test, should self-isolate and get a confirmatory polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test. This is recorded in school as code X (authorised absence), until it has been confirmed by a PCR Test showing a student has Covid-19. Thereafter, the attendance recorded as an I Code (illness, authorised absence), until they are able to return to school.
- If a student tests negative and feels well, they can stop self-isolating and return to school.

- If the student remains unwell and stays home, following a negative test (for other reasons), then they will also be recorded as code I (illness, authorised absence).
- Students who are a close contact of someone (particularly siblings), should get a PCR test, and must only self-isolate if they test positive.

While Covid related absence will effect student absence, this is closely monitored in school to ensure students are not penalised for this period of absence.

- Year 10 progress information and end of year targets will be published to the Sims app next week followed by Year 12 information immediately before half term.
- Year 9 end of year targets will be published before half term with progress information in January after assessments have been taken.
- Year 7 and 8 assessments are happening immediately after half term. Revision lists will start to appear for students within MS Teams over the forthcoming week.
