### Update letter for families – 26<sup>th</sup> November

This week saw the start of the Year 11 Trial Examinations, an important moment for GCSE students to benchmark their progress. It was a wonderful sight to see the after school Interact Sessions full of Year 11 students revising with their teachers and peers. Given the lack of experience in sitting a formal exam in a hall, their behaviour was exemplary and we wish the best of luck as these assessments continue until Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December.

A reminder to families that keeping classrooms well ventilated is one of our main controls, and several classrooms are now fitted with CO<sub>2</sub> meters that signal to staff when to open windows. Given the weather has changed, we advise that students consider wearing their <u>school</u> jumpers under their blazers to help maintain a good level of thermal comfort. ### 6<sup>th</sup> Form UCAS applications

Year 13 students continue to submit their applications to UCAS and for Degree Apprenticeships. Thus far, students have received Conditional Offers to study: Maths, Physics, Engineering, Law, Bio-Medical Sciences and Psychology. Four students have also received invitation to interview for courses at Cambridge University with a further two students receiving interview invitations for nursing.

Other children ideally should wait 12 weeks from a positive test.

# **Teaching and Learning update**

Staff are helping students understand their own progress in lessons, by using a range of strategies that show their knowledge. In lessons, teachers will be checking understanding regularly, and will be adapting lessons as they teach to ensure that all students can make progress. In Maths, this may be writing on desks (in wipeable pen!) so that teachers can see the working out and address any misconceptions, or in Art by looking at other students' work, or in English by asking students what makes a good answer. By ensuring students are kept aware of where they are and what they can do, we are helping them to improve.
