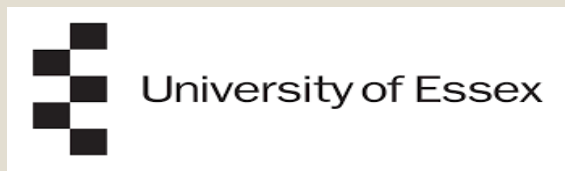

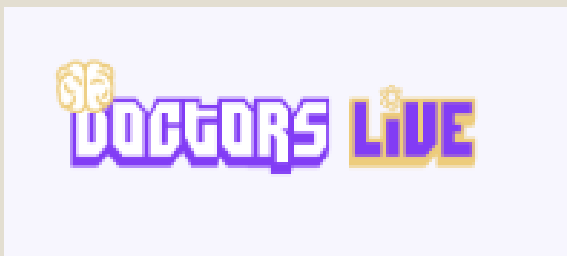

SurgeryLive - Virtual Surgical Theatre Operating Experience - Saturday 6th July 2024

Our **SurgeryLive** course is an **innovative and interactive virtual course** that gives students a real glimpse of what it's like to be a **surgeon** in an operating theatre, delivered by practising surgeons. The day course includes:

1. A glimpse into the day-to-day life of a surgeon
2. Solving real-life surgical cases, including history taking and anonymized scans
3. Live virtual operations - showing step by step how common surgeries are carried out
4. Learning how to suture with a live follow-along demo (students will be sent their own suturing kit, the same ones used by medical students and doctors)
